CARPARK

At the beginning of the year it is a good time for a reminder about our carpark rules. As a shared environment it is important that we show care,



respect, courtesy and patience when accessing the carpark. Double parking within the carpark either with or without a driver is prohibited. There is usually ample parking in Grantham Road and your children will be cared for by staff if you are not here precisely when the bell goes in the afternoon. In the morning there is no access to the bottom carpark after 8:10am. This is for safety reasons and there are no exceptions. We ask that anyone dropping children to school is made aware of this rule including mums, dads, siblings and grandparents. The Kiss and Drop zone operates outside the hall each morning ensuring a safe and smooth drop off. This is supervised each morning by a member of the leadership team. To ensure a smooth flow parents are asked not to get out of the car to farewell their children and children are encouraged to be ready to alight when the car stops. There are two drop off spaces in the Kiss and Drop zone and parents are asked to make sure that they utilise both spaces. Carers not following the carpark guidelines will be approached by staff to remind them of the expectations. It is important that we all follow these rules to ensure the children's safety. Out and About

Our new school year has begun



smoothly. Today was a special day as we welcomed our new Kindergarten students into our community. It is always exciting to see these students and their parents as they begin their time at OLOL. This year is a year of change for us at OLOL. As well as some staff changes, we have a couple of procedural changes as well. This year we are changing the structure of our RFF - that is the time the classroom teacher is released from face to face teaching to prepare and plan for classroom instruction. Previously our RFF was made up of Music and Library with the children in Kindergarten and Year 1 having a half hour music and library lesson each week while Years 2 – 6 had an hour music and library lessons on alternate weeks. That is one week they would have Library the next week they would have Music. An additional half an hour of release a week was given by other teachers across the school. This year we have decided to consolidate our RFF into an hour and a half session each week split between Creative Arts (incorporating Music/Drama and Dance) and PDHPE. To facilitate this Mrs Willemse will take classes for Creative Arts and we have employed a specialist PE teacher, Mrs Veronica Brogden, to take classes for PDHPE. Depending upon class timetables it may be that your child will be required to wear their sports uniform twice within the week. The days on which your child is required to wear their sports uniform are shown elsewhere in this newsletter. We believe that this new structure will allow us to provide more specialised instruction in the areas of Creative Arts and PDHPE and at the same time minimise class disruption. Another change is the introduction of a school jumper. This is in response to parent requests. Please note that the jumper is an *optional* part of the school uniform. Due to its cost it can be purchased on an order and pay basis only and orders will only be placed once in each school year. A detailed letter will be sent home next week detailing the procedure in relation to purchasing the new jumper.

Once again I look forward to working with you all throughout 2017.
