# MOVING SCHOOL

The Catholic Education Office has developed a Policy relating to the notice required from parents to terminate their children's enrolment in the schools of the Parramatta Diocese. In part this states that "A term's notice" (10 weeks) in writing must be given to the Principal before the removal of a student or a full term's fees will be paid. The notice can be given any time during the term for the next term. This means that unless the school receives a term's notice no pro rata adjustment will be given for part term tuition. Notice in writing will be accepted at any time

during Term 4 in relation to the following year's enrolment. In this circumstance the requirement for 10 weeks notice will be waived.

Welcome back to Term 4. It will be a very busy term as always. For some of our



students they will be completing the final phase of their *first* or *last* Primary school year.

Next week we will begin our compulsory Swimming Program. This is a great opportunity for the students to learn new skills or further refine their water safety awareness coming into the summer months. Whether your child is a beginner or a confident swimmer, the program will cater to their needs.

The swimming program also offers an opportunity for the children to develop other life skills as well. Such as; being an active listener, following instructions and participating in a group. Further skills include; organisation, independence and caring for their belongings. To assist your child to locate their own things, please *label* all of their items (goggles, towel...even school clothes). It is important to have your child pack and unpack, their own swimming bag each day, developing responsibility. A good strategy is to have a checklist (such as the one below) in their room or on the fridge for the 8 days to assist them in remembering all of the items they need for each day. Children will often say "mum forgot to pack it". I am sure the children will enjoy this special time with their school friends and the teachers will assist them to adapt to the change in routine. Teaching timetables have been adjusted to ensure there is as little disruption as possible to the learning during this time.
