

Once again we will award prizes for the most creative entries and share the recommendations with the community. So come on OLOL let us know what are your "Hot Book Pics" these holidays.



International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS) in Science, Mathematics, Writing and English

From this year, I.C.A.S Assessments will be completed online, except for Year 3 & 4 Writing. ICAS Assessments are designed to assess students' ability to use classroom and curriculum learning in new contexts, requiring the use of higher-order thinking and problem-solving skills.

Below you will find information about I.C.A.S. These competitions, run by the Educational Testing Centre of the University of NSW, are open to all students in Years 3 to 6. Although they are an excellent **enrichment activity**, for some children they are **quite rigorous** so please consider the **suitability** for your child. Please note that this year we are offering **4** competition papers.

Parents can access this service by typing <u>unsw.global/parentpay</u> into a browser.

We have been asked by the bus companies to remind parents and students of the requirement for students to tap on with their OPAL cards when they are travelling to and from school. If the bus routes are not seen to being used , as tracked by the OPAL cards then it could be the case that the service is discontinued.
